

#### **Parish Council News**

At its meeting in January, the Council agreed the budget for 2022/3 and to hold the precept at its current level.

Richard Langston's offer to maintain the telephone box was accepted with gratitude.

The Clerk was asked to collect the information needed to seek a speed limit on part of Fen Road.

The Council resolved to remove the two notices on the Village Green and to erect 3 wooden posts positioned so as to present a barrier to vehicles damaging the green.

It was resolved that he Clerk be authorised to update information about the village's activities on its website. Organisations should contact the Clerk to have their details kept up to date.

The Council discussed and agreed some measures for dealing with urgent action needed between meetings.
