PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

At its Annual meeting, the Council approved the accounts for 2021/2 and set the date for which they will be open for inspection as 13 to 22 July. Dave Ireland was thanked for cutting the grass on the Village Green and a quotation from a contractor was accepted.

The Council agreed that a time capsule be placed on the Green to celebrate the Platinum Jubilee. It was also agreed that the Hinderclay sign on the Redgrave Road be replaced.

With next year's elections in mind, the Members adopted a formal procedure for co-option to the Council.

Mid-Suffolk Council is conducting a Local Governance Review. Hinderclay Parish Council, after some debate, voted 3:2 in favour of maintain the present arrangement. The full Minutes are available on the Village Website: hinderclay.onesuffolk.net
