Patients may recall that PPG volunteers asked, if you attended the
Botesdale Practice in early June this year, if you would like to complete a
survey about Enhanced Access to the Practice i.e. appointments
available in evenings and weekends.

The following is a summation of findings.

□ 139 surveys were completed throughout the Primary Care Network-PCN (which is combined - Stanton & Woolpit (89 surveys) and Botesdale (50) completed)

Overall 87% of Patients stated that they would like to have the flexibility to book appointments at a time and place of their convenience, with 79 per cent welcoming weekday evening access and 78% Saturdays.

□ Around 25% of patients surveyed were aware of the extended opening hours at practice level.

□ Awareness and usage of the GP plus service in Bury St Edmunds was extremely low with only 2 per cent of patients having actually used the service.

All Hallows' Eve

All Hallows' Eve falls on **31st October** each year, and is the day before <u>All Hallows' Day</u>, also known as <u>All Saints' Day</u> in the Christian calendar. The Church traditionally held a vigil on All Hallows' Eve when worshippers would prepare themselves with prayers and fasting prior to the feast day itself.

The name derives from the Old English 'hallowed' meaning holy or sanctified and is now usually contracted to the more familiar word Hallowe'en.
