HINDERCLAY CHRISTMAS COFFEE MORNING

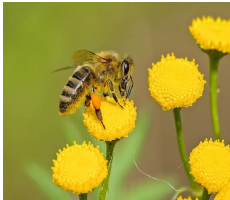

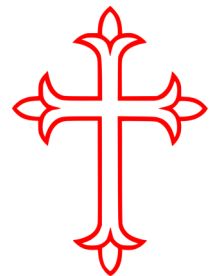

Redgrave and Lopham Fen TWILIGHT WALK

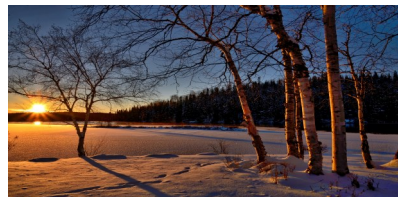
TUESDAY 6TH December, 2.30—4.30pm

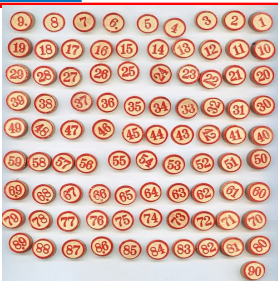

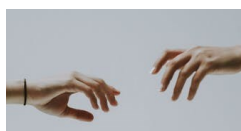
