Paper, newspapers, magazines and junk mail

Paperback and hardback books

Plastic bathroom and household cleaning products (please keep tops on)

Plastic bottles (please squash and keep lids on)

Plastic yoghurt pots, tubs and food trays

If an item is not listed above, please keep it out of recycling bin.
